

Brent Parkin is a guitar player, singer songwriter and veteran of the Winnipeg Music Scene, playing for audiences in Winnipeg and across Canada for over forty years. In the early 70's he co-founded the popular blues bands Houndog and Brent Parkin and the Stingers and is an alumni member of the Front Porch Blues Review and Swing Soniq

Brent's music is a combination of Chicago Style Blues, Swing, Jump Blues and Roots Music. For his solo shows you can hear shades of **Leon Redbone**, **Tampa Red**, **Merle Travis**, **Robert Johnson** and **Brent Parkin** originals.
